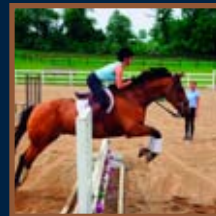

EQUESTRIAN Aquidneck Island is steeped in the tradition of riding. Organized amateur and professional polo thrives locally within minutes of the Carnegie Abbey Club, and in Newport the legacy of horse-drawn carriages is regularly revived every summer. At Carnegie Abbey, enjoy old-world elegance and the timeless nobility of riding in an incomparable setting—through rustic trails and across windswept hills overlooking the Bay.

TENNIS Sport at the Carnegie Abbey Club is healthy and animated. Especially tennis, around which camaraderie, tournament play, expert instruction, tea at courtside, and the simple exercise of hitting the ball with friends are understood pleasures.

Carnegie Abbey Club members are granted membership at the prestigious International Tennis Hall of Fame in Newport—a museum of the game and its history, and an active sporting complex in its own right. YACHTING The Yacht Club is the nucleus of sailing and yachting activity at the Carnegie Abbey Club. Our staff offers private lessons in a wide variety of craft, and Narragansett Bay provides an incomparable learning environment. All classes of sailboats compete on these waters every day.

Narragansett Bay and Rhode Island Sound offer some of the best sailing and sportfishing on the eastern seaboard. Native game fish range from bluefish to bluefin tuna. For the angler, fishing outings from the Carnegie Abbey Club, can be arranged from spring through late fall.
